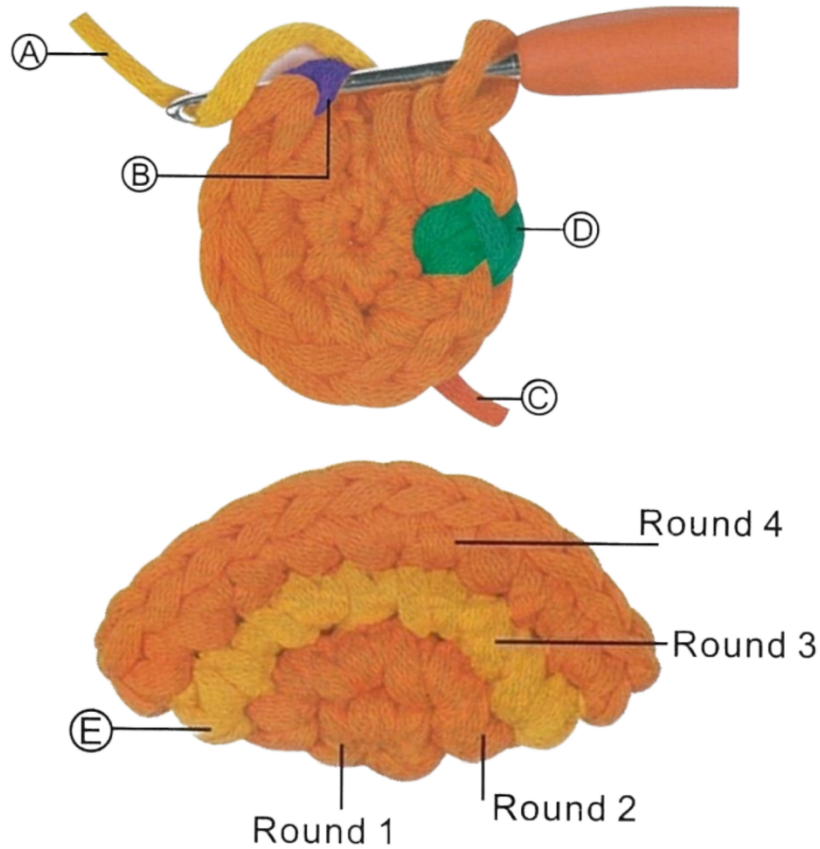

Terminology



- | | |
|--------------------------------|--|
| A Working yarn | Yarn connected to the ball of yarn. |
| B Top loops of a stitch | Where you usually insert the hook, to start the next stitch. |
| C Yarn tail(end) | End of yarn not connected to the ball of yarn. |
| D Single crochet stitch | The main stitch used in amigurumi. |
| E Round | A series of crochet stitches in a circle.
This illustrated crochet piece is made of 4 rounds. |

Abbreviations

This pattern is written in US terminology

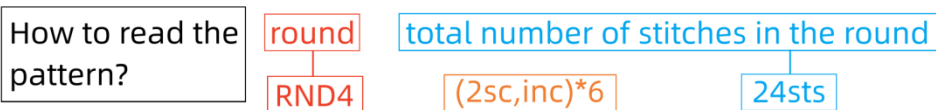
ch	chain stitch	tr	treble crochet
sc	single crochet	ss	slip stitch
inc	increase	st	stitch
dec	decrease	BLO	through back loops only
hdc	half double crochet	FLO	through front loops only
dc	double crochet		

(...) work all instructions in the brackets as many times as directed

[...] work all instructions in square brackets into the same stitch

The instructions to make your very own doll.



What stitches to do in this round, and how many times

For round 4, repeat the pattern in the brackets for 6 times. The pattern is: single crochet in each of the first 2 stitches, then increase stitch in the next stitch. Because an increase is actually 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch, the total number of stitches in this round is 24.

Materials:

Yarn, Crochet hooks, Stitch markers, Scissors
Yarn needle, Safety eyes, Doll's stuffing

Abbreviations:

ch: chain stitch	rep: Repeat(s)
sc: single crochet	Rnd(s): rounds
inc: increase	beg: Begin/beginning
dec: decrease	lp(s): loops
ss: slip stitch	sk: Skip(ped)
st: stitch	sp(s): spaces
hdc: half double crochet	tog: Together
dc: double crochet	Yo/yoh: Yarn over/yarn over hook

fpdc = front post double crochet

(,,,)*n = work all instructions in the brackets as many times as directed.

[,,,] = work all instructions in square brackets into the same stitch.

If you are a beginner to crocheting and have never crocheted before, we recommend to scan the code to watch the basic stitches and practice them, so that you can make amigurumi easier.

1 Girl Body (make 1)

(With yellow yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring: 1ch, 6sc, ss=6sts

Place a stitch marker in first st, moving the stitch marker up with each rnd, cont as folls.

Rnd2: 1ch, 6inc, ss=12sts

Rnd3: 1ch, (sc, inc)*6 times, ss=18sts

Rnd4: 1ch, (sc, inc, sc)*6 times, ss=24sts

Rnd5: 1ch, (3sc, inc)*6 times, ss=30sts

Rnd6: 1ch, (2sc, inc, 2sc)*6 times, ss=36sts

Rnds7-9: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

Eyes: Insert safety eyes between rounds 4-5 of the main body.

Spacing them 10 stitches apart.

(With pink yarn)

Rnds10-12: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

(With purple yarn)

Rnds13-15: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

(With blue yarn)

Rnds16-18: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

(With yellow yarn)

Rnds19-21:1ch,36sc,ss=36sts

Rnd22:1ch,(2sc,dec,2sc)*6 times,ss=30sts

Rnd23:1ch,(3sc,dec)*6 times,ss=24sts

Rnd24:1ch,(sc,dec,sc)*6 times,ss=18sts

Stuffing

Rnd25:1ch,(sc,dec)*6 times,ss=12sts

Rnd26:1ch,6dec,ss=6sts

Fasten off. Leave enough yarn tail for sewing.

Use a yarn needle to sew hole closed by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches, weave in yarn tail.

2 Wings (make 2)

(With white yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring: 1ch, 6sc, ss=6sts

Place a stitch marker in first st, moving the stitch marker up with each rnd, cont as folls.

Rnd2: 1ch, 6inc, ss=12sts

Rnd3: 1ch, (sc, inc)*6 times, ss=18sts

Rnds4-7: 1ch, 18sc, ss=18sts

Rnd8: 1ch, (sc, dec)*6 times, ss=12sts

Fasten off and leave enough yarn tail for sewing.

3 Bowknot (make 1)

(With pink yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring: 2ch, 2dc, 2ch, ss, 2ch, 2dc, 2ch, ss

Fasten off and leave enough yarn tail for sewing.

4 Sew up

Mouth: Use black yarn, embroider a smiley mouth between rounds 2-3 of the body. Spanning 3 stitches.

Wings: Sew the wings between rounds 10-16 of the main body on both side. Bilateral symmetry.

Bowknot: Sew the bowknot between rounds 6-7 on the right side of the body.

1 Boy Body (make 1)

(With yellow yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring: 1ch, 6sc, ss=6sts

Place a stitch marker in first st, moving the stitch marker up with each rnd, cont as folls.

Rnd2: 1ch, 6inc, ss=12sts

Rnd3: 1ch, (sc, inc)*6 times, ss=18sts

Rnd4: 1ch, (sc, inc, sc)*6 times, ss=24sts

Rnd5: 1ch, (3sc, inc)*6 times, ss=30sts

Rnd6: 1ch, (2sc, inc, 2sc)*6 times, ss=36sts

Rnds7-9: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

Eyes: Insert safety eyes between rounds 4-5 of the main body.

Spacing them 10 stitches apart.

(With blue yarn)

Rnds10-12: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

(With purple yarn)

Rnds13-15: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

(With pink yarn)

Rnds16-18: 1ch, 36sc, ss=36sts

(With yellow yarn)

Rnds19-21:1ch,36sc,ss=36sts

Rnd22:1ch,(2sc,dec,2sc)*6 times,ss=30sts

Rnd23:1ch,(3sc,dec)*6 times,ss=24sts

Rnd24:1ch,(sc,dec,sc)*6 times,ss=18sts

Stuffing

Rnd25:1ch,(sc,dec)*6 times,ss=12sts

Rnd26:1ch,6dec,ss=6sts

Fasten off. Leave enough yarn tail for sewing.

Use a yarn needle to sew hole closed by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches, weave in yarn tail.

2 Wings (make 2)

(With white yarn)

Rnd1: Working into a magic ring: 1ch, 6sc, ss=6sts

Place a stitch marker in first st, moving the stitch marker up with each rnd, cont as folls.

Rnd2: 1ch, 6inc, ss=12sts

Rnd3: 1ch, (sc, inc)*6 times, ss=18sts

Rnds4-7: 1ch, 18sc, ss=18sts

Rnd8: 1ch, (sc, dec)*6 times, ss=12sts

Fasten off and leave enough yarn tail for sewing.

3 Sew up

Mouth: Use black yarn, embroider a smiley mouth between rounds 2-3 of the body. Spanning 3 stitches.

Wings: Sew the wings between rounds 10-16 of the main body on both side. Bilateral symmetry.
