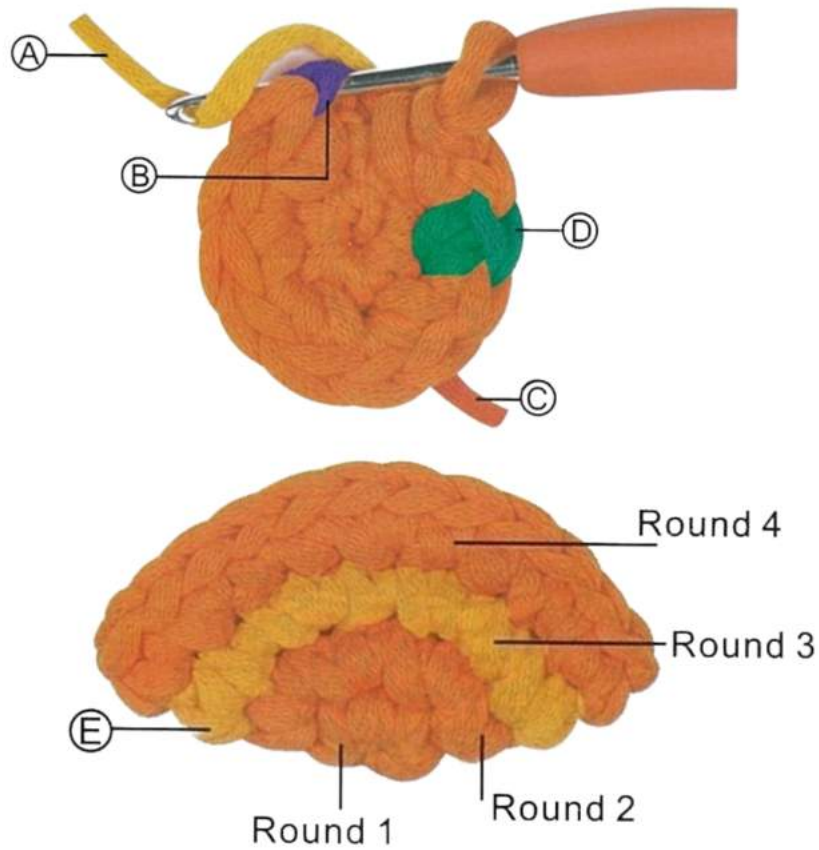

Terminology

|--------------------------------|--|
| A Working yarn | Yarn connected to the ball of yarn. |
| B Top loops of a stitch | Where you usually insert the hook, to start the next stitch. |
| C Yarn tail(end) | End of yarn not connected to the ball of yarn. |
| D Single crochet stitch | The main stitch used in amigurumi. |
| E Round | A series of crochet stitches in a circle.
This illustrated crochet piece is made of 4 rounds. |

Yarn, Crochet hook, Stitch markers, Scissors, Yarn needle

Abbreviations:

ch - chain stitch

sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet

ss/sl, st - slip stitch

Rnd(s) - round(s)

sk - skip

yo/yoh - yarn over/yarn over hook

FLO - Front Loops Only

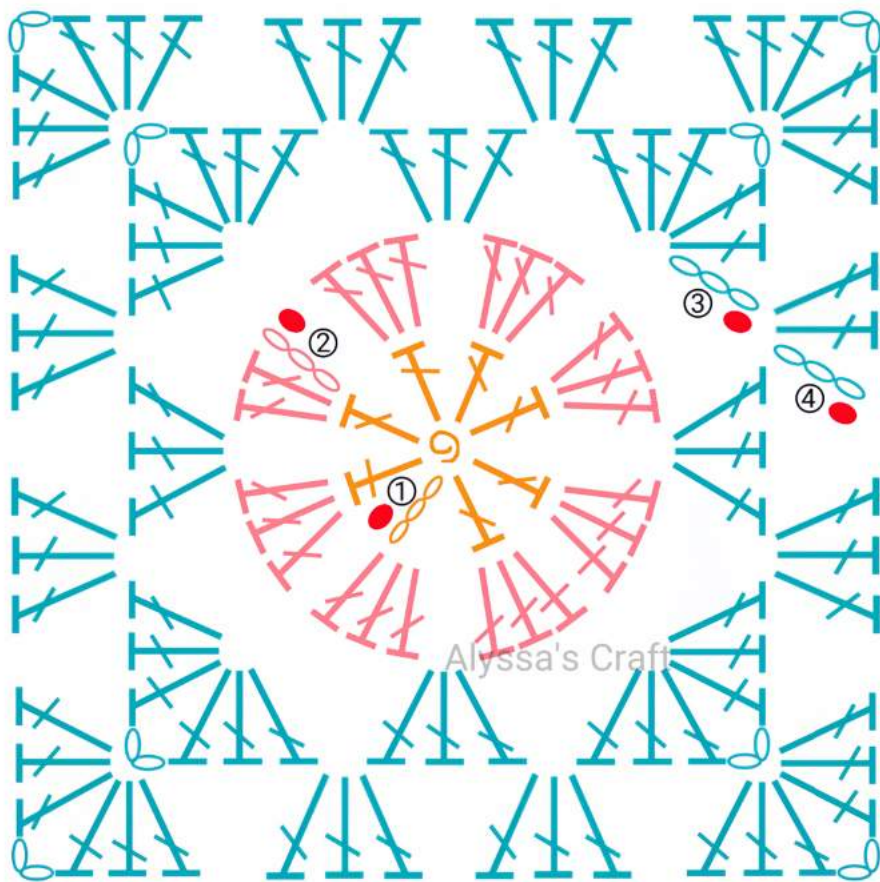
BLO - Back Loops Only

(,,)*n = work all instructions in the brackets as many times as directed.

[,,] = work all instructions in square brackets into the same stitch.

Daisy Granny Square

- Ⓞ magic ring(mc)
- chain stitch(ch)
- slip stitch(ss/sl,st)
- ⌘ double crochet(dc)



Daisy Granny Square

If you are a beginner to crocheting and have never crocheted before, we recommend to scan the code to watch the basic stitches and practice them, so that you can make blanket easier.

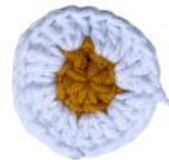
(With ginger yarn)

R1: Magic ring: ch,3ch (count as 1 dc), 7dc,ss
Place a stitch marker in the third ch



(With white yarn)

R2:[3ch (count as 1 dc),2dc],3dc*7 times,ss



(With green yarn)

R3:[3ch (count as 1 dc),2dc,2ch,3dc],3dc,
([3dc,2ch,3dc],3dc)*3 times,ss



R4:[3ch (count as 1 dc),2dc],
([3dc,2ch,3dc],3dc,3dc)*3 times
[3dc,2ch,3dc],3dc,ss

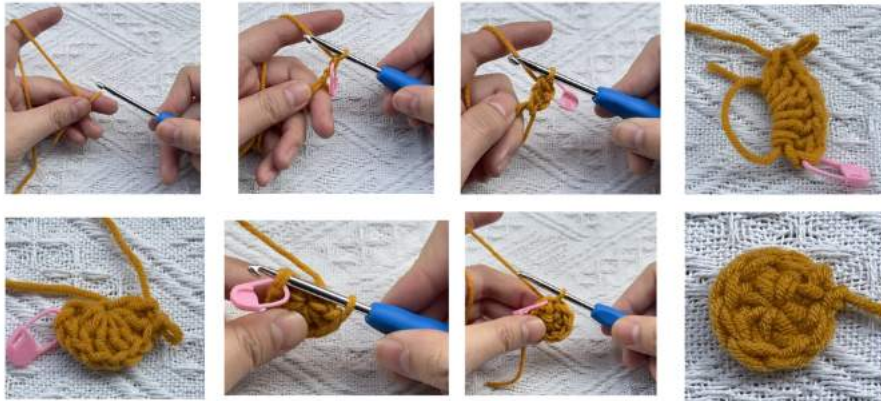


Daisy granny square
size about: 3.5"X3.5"

You need to crochet 80 pieces daisy granny square in total.

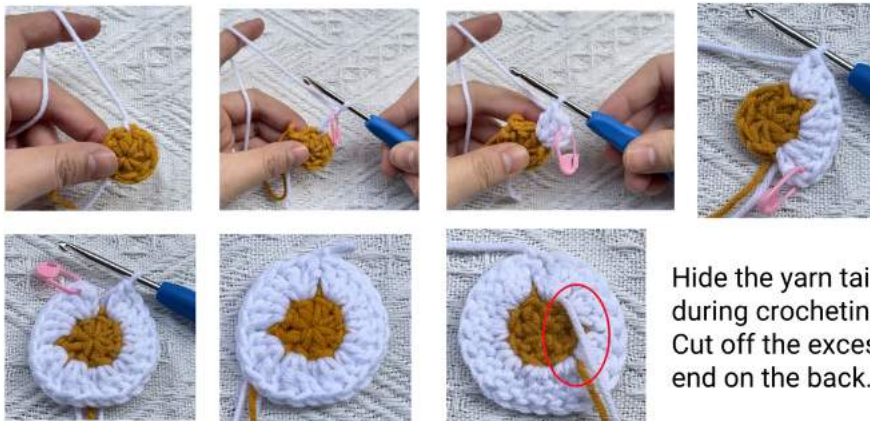
Daisy Granny Square

Rnd 1: (With ginger yarn) :Start with magic ring.Work 3ch (count as 1 dc). Then work 7dc in the ring,there're 8dc in total.Finally join with a slip stitch(ss) in the top chain stitch of the 3ch we made.Cut off the yarn.



Rnd 2: (Attach the white yarn) :The crochet hook is inserted into the stitch, not into the hole.I like attach the white yarn through the second stitch on the right side of the ss.Also you can insert hook into any one of the stitches.

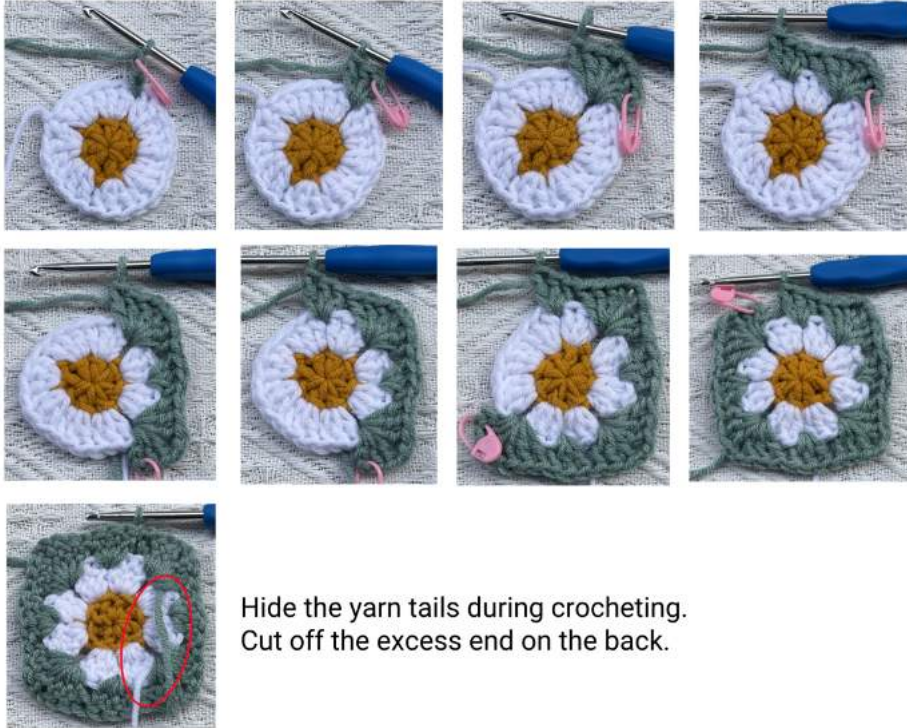
Work 3ch (count as 1 dc),and work 2 more dc in the same stitch.(The yarn tail over the crochet hook).Then work 3dc in each stitch for 7 times.Finally join with a slip stitch(ss) in the top chain stitch of the 3ch we made.Cut off the yarn.



Hide the yarn tails during crocheting. Cut off the excess end on the back.

Rnd 3: (Attach green yarn). The crochet hook is inserted into the hole. I like to attach the green yarn through the second hole on the right side of the ss. Also you can insert hook into any one of the hole.

Work 3ch (count as 1 dc), work 2 dc, 2ch, 3dc in the same hole. (The yarn tail are over the crochet hook). We work 3dc in the next hole. Work ([3dc, 2ch, 3dc], 3dc) for 3 times. Finally join with a ss in the top ch of the 3ch we made. We don't need to cut off the yarn.



Hide the yarn tails during crocheting.
Cut off the excess end on the back.

Rnd 4: (With green yarn). Work [3ch(count as 1 dc),2dc]. (Also you can work 3dc). (The yarn tail are over the crochet hook).
Work ([3dc,2ch,3dc],3dc,3dc) for 3 times.[3dc,2ch,3dc],3dc.Finally join with a ss in the top ch of the 3ch we made.Cut off the yarn.



Use a yarn needle to conceal the yarn tail on the back.



The daisy granny square have been completed.Please finished 80 pieces daisy granny squares by yourself.

The daisy blanket will be made up of 8x10 granny squares.

Sewing Method

Method 1: "V" Shape

I'm using two granny squares for demonstration, with the front side facing up. Align both sides.

A regular stitch (a "V") has 2 loops. The loop outside is the front loop. While the other one inside is the back loop.

We'll crochet through back loops only (BLO) for sewing.

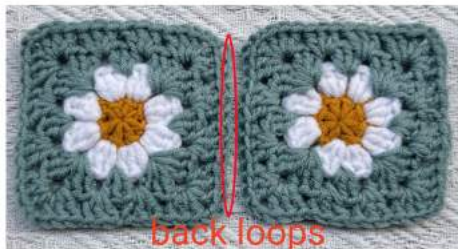
Make a knot on the hook. The white yarn under the granny squares.

Insert the crochet hook into the BLO of the two granny squares. Yarn over and pull through 3 loops on hook (2 green loops and 1 white loop).

Repeat, until you complete it.

If you meet crossing point, just work 1 or 2 ch.

When you finished, work 1 ch, cut off the yarn, use a yarn needle to conceal the yarn tails.



Method 2: Single Crochets(sc)

Align the two granny squares, Fold the two granny squares and stand them up, with the front side facing yourself.

Make a knot on the hook. Insert the hook into the stitches of both granny squares. Yarn over and pull up a loop. There're 2 loops on the hook, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook. Repeat.

When you finished, work 1 ch, cut off the yarn, use a yarn needle to conceal the yarn tails.



Method 3:Slip Stitch(ss)

With the front side facing up.Align both sides.

Make a knot on the hook.The white yarn under the granny squares.

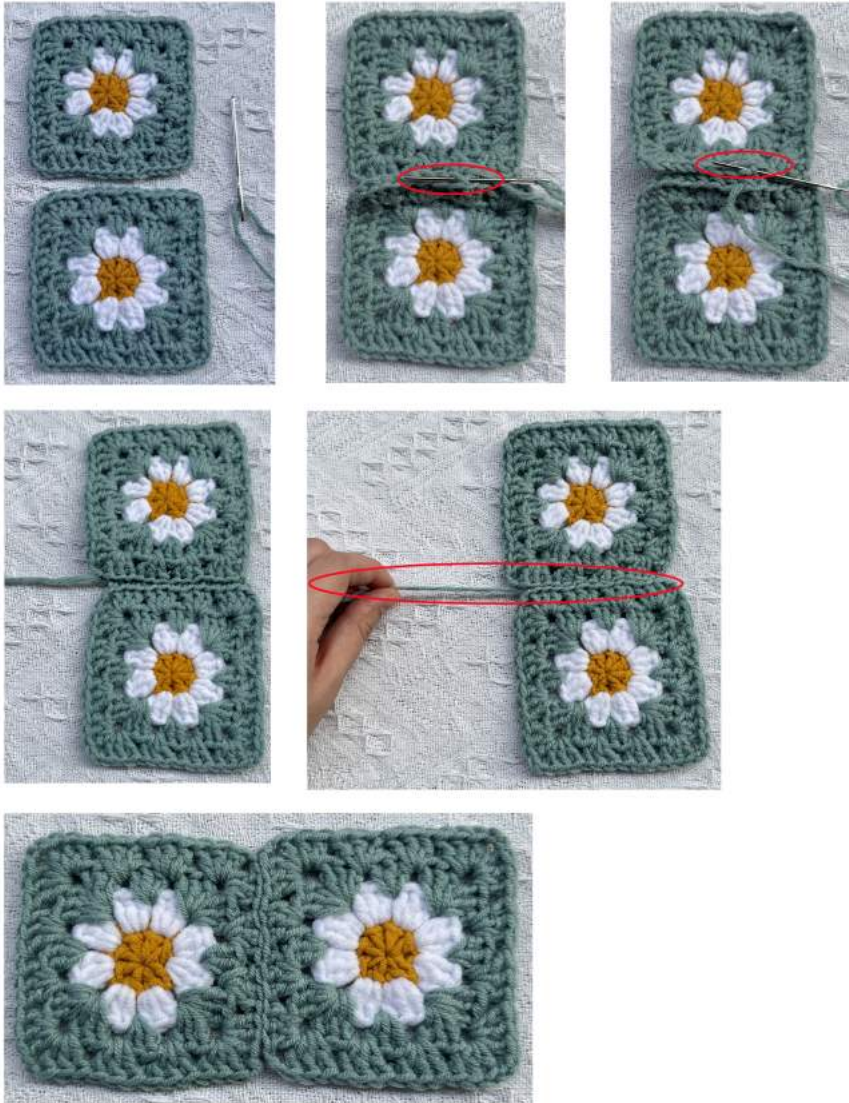
Insert the crochet hook into the stitch,yarn over and pull up a loop, there're 2 loops on the hook.(2 white loops).Then pull the first loop on hook through the original loop on hook.Repeat,work ss in turn on the left and right granny squares.

When you finished,work 1 ch,cut off the yarn,use a yarn needle to conceal the yarn tails.



Method 4: Through 2 adjacent BLO

I will use green yarn with a yarn needle for demonstration.
Take enough length of yarn. Insert the yarn needle through 2 adjacent Back Loops Only (BLO) in turn on the left and right granny square.
When you finished, pull the yarn tighter to close, and conceal the yarn tail in the back.



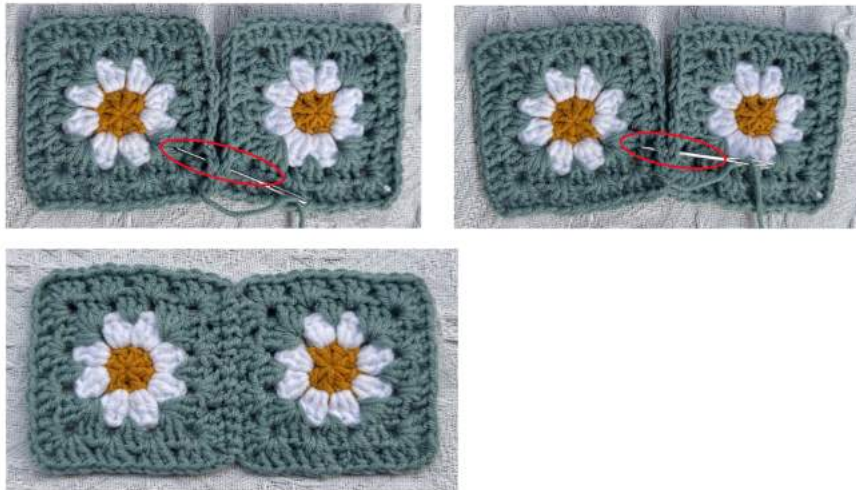
Method 5: Through the stitch in turn inside

I will use green yarn with a yarn needle for demonstration.
Take enough length of yarn. Align both sides. Use a yarn needle
insert stitch in turn from inside of both granny squares.
When you finished, conceal the yarn tail in the back.



Method 6: Through the stitch of both sides

I will use green yarn with a yarn needle for demonstration.
Take enough length of yarn. Align both sides. Use a yarn needle
into the stitch of both granny squares.
When you finished, conceal the yarn tail in the back.



Border

I will use 1 piece granny square for demonstration.
After all the granny squares are sewn up. Work 1 single crochet (sc) in each stitch. Insert hook into the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull it through both of loops on hook.
When you finished, work 1 slip stitch (ss).



Petals: Skip 1 st, [2dc, 1ch, 2dc], skip 1 st, ss. Repeat
